Abstract: A waterbody represents significant areas of water accumulation within the District of Saanich. Waterbodies are mostly naturally occurring geographical features but can be man-made as well. The municipal water network is comprised of connected open channel watercourses, waterbodies, and storm pipes.

Purpose: A waterbody is captured to spatially represent all significant areas of water accumulation within the District of Saanich.
